3) With sombreros.exe highlighted, select 'Add Resource' from the Edit Menu.

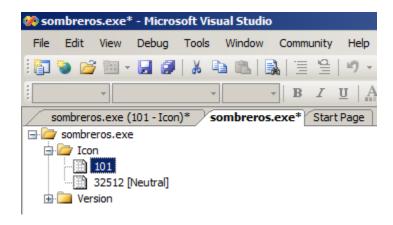

A file open box will appear. Direct the box to the folder location of your custom icons. Type ***.ico** for the filename, and hit enter, to show only the icon files that are available.

Select the first icon, in our example it is '001.ico', and click on 'Open' to import the file into the executable. After the icon has been imported, it will display in Visual Studio. Click on the 'sombreros.exe' tab next:



The file icon number '**101**' should be associated with the icon file we just imported. With '101' highlighted, right-click to show a menu, and select 'properties'.

In the properties window, the ID is currently set to '101'. We need to change this to '001'.
